High Impact Achievements Showcased in China

The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) will showcase a variety of recent achievements across its high impact research areas during the 7th annual China Hi-Tech Fair (CHTF).

On exhibit will be approximately 20 projects spanning three themes deriving from the HKUST [Strategic Plan 2005-2020](#): Strategic Areas, China Strategy and Entrepreneurship Center Companies.

Under Strategic Areas, HKUST introduces the five high-impact areas outlined in the *Strategic Plan 2005-2020* published in June - nanoscience and technology; biological sciences and biotechnology; electronics, wireless and information technology; environment and sustainable development; management education and research - and showcases new products and technologies successfully developed in these areas.



Since the Strategic Plan also envisages the University's expansion in the Mainland, the China Strategy theme will allow the University to demonstrate some of its latest undertakings in the Mainland. These include the Zhejiang Advanced Manufacturing Institute, the Shenzhen-Hong Kong Institution (Industry-Education-Research), the School of Business and Management's MBA Program in Shenzhen, and the newly established HKUST R and D Corporation (Guangzhou) Ltd.

In the Entrepreneurship Center Companies section, five start-ups will demonstrate their research achievements, covering a number of technological areas including high-brightness LED fabrication, low power wireless IC, motion controllers, network applications, and speech recognition solutions.

CHTF is a state-level fair jointly hosted by the Ministry of Commerce, the Ministry of Science and Technology, the Ministry of Information Industry, the National Development and Reform Commission, the Ministry of Education, the State Intellectual Property Office, the Chinese Academy of Sciences, the Academy of Engineering, and the Shenzhen Municipal People's Government.
